



ECHO PARK LAKE REHABILITATION PROJECT

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: November 5, 2011

STORMWATER DIVERSION INSTALLATION AT THE CORNER OF ECHO PARK AVENUE AND PARK AVENUE

On the week of November 14, crews will begin Phase 2 of the stormwater diversion structure installation in Park Avenue. Construction will continue through the end of January 2012.

Duration:	2 ½ months
Construction Hours:	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and some weekends
Construction Method:	Open trench (In the interest of safety, the trench will be plated and secured at the end of each work day.)



Impacts:

- **TRAFFIC.** No vehicular access on Park Avenue at the corner of Echo Park Avenue. Vehicles driving east on Park Avenue will be detoured to Logan Street.
- **STREET PARKING.** Street parking on Park Avenue will be removed in the immediate construction area. Also, the "No Parking" restriction on the west side of Echo Park Avenue between Park Avenue and the Boat House will remain in effect.

- **PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC.** Sidewalks and alternate pedestrian access will be provided on both sides of Park Avenue. All pedestrians are encouraged to use designated crosswalks.
- **BUS STOPS.** The stops for the Pico Union/Echo Park DASH on Echo Park Avenue, just north of Park Avenue, will be temporarily out of service. Bus riders are requested to access the bus stops at the corner of Echo Park Avenue and Sunset Boulevard, and at the corner of Echo Park Avenue and Laguna Avenue.

LAKE DRAINING

The draining of the lake was completed in October but recent rains refilled portions of the lake with water. The lake water will be drained again at a later date, and pumped into the sewer system.

Members of your neighborhood have volunteered to be part of the Echo Park Lake Odor Monitoring Committee. If you catch unusual odors from the lake draining, please call (213) 978-0317 immediately.

OTHER CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Crews will continue the installation of a storm drain pipe on the east side of the lake, and the removal of the lake edge by the lotus bed area.

Construction on the Boat House is approximately 30 percent complete. Ongoing work includes the installation of the structural steel, the wood framing for the structural retrofit, the sump pump pit, and the grease interceptor.
